Bylaws

1. Name:

Tau Kappa Epsilon (TKE) Ottawa Area Alumni Association

2. Purpose:

- To uphold the general welfare, campus, prestige, and the scholastic, personal and educational interests of the Tau Omega Chapter of TKE Fraternity as well as any other local TKE chapters
- To provide an organization through which alumni members of the chapter and those alumni of other chapters residing in the Ottawa area, may continue and improve their contacts with each other and with their undergraduate Fraters

3. Annual Objectives:

- Provide at least one undergraduate scholarship
- Sponsor one rush event during each of the fall/ spring rush periods
- Hold at least one alumni event per quarter
- In conjunction with the undergraduate chapter, participate in at least one joint undergraduate/ alumni event per school semester
- Support all undergraduate activities and events
- Act as a resource for the local undergraduate chapter(s)
- Maintain communication ties with all alumni Fraters
- Foster lifelong participation in the Fraternity, its activities and its ideals
- Establish and maintain a mentoring program

4. Membership:

Automatic for all initiated Fraters in good standing:

- a) Of Tau Omega chapter, who hold alumni status; and
- b) Of another chapter, but living in or working in the National Capital Region (NCR).

5. Dues:

- Voluntary
- \$50 per year or \$1000 lifetime membership
- If desired, lifetime membership can be paid over a one year period

6. Meetings:

- At least one general meeting per University semester (September – December and January – April)
- At least one executive board/ board of directors meeting per University semester (September – December and January – April)
- Announced at minimum via email and WWW at least three weeks in advance
- Decisions of the Association can also be made via email or live chat
- Agenda will be prepared in advance and affirmed at commencement of meeting
- Records of proceedings and decisions are to be posted to entire membership no later than 10 days following a meeting

7. Executive Board:

- Officers of the Association are elected during a general business meeting and hold biennial terms. Officers of the Association shall consist of at least the following, with others being appointed by the executive board as required:
 - President
 - Vice-President
 - Treasurer
 - Secretary
